1. Students who have completed their studies abroad (which are comparable to the Spanish Baccalaureate degree):

- The registration form sealed by the corresponding banking entity, in the case of a transfer, the original copy of the same.
- Photocopy of national ID document or passport (certification not required).
- Certified copy of the equivalence recognition to the Spanish Baccalaureate degree. At the time of notarizing the request, evidence should be provided via documentation issued by the competent body, recognising equivalence of the foreign degrees to the Spanish Baccalaureate degree. In the absence of the above, the original of the sheet proving that the recognition has been requested may be submitted, in which case the results of the exams would be of a conditional nature.
- Original academic transcript or certified copy, translated and notarized (when necessary) for the grades obtained in the Baccalaureate for courses equivalent to 1st and 2nd years of Spanish Baccalaureate studies. (If any of these certifications were already sent to the PAU-Selectivity Admissions Department, please make note of this).

CALCULATION OF AVERAGE TRANSCRIPT SCORES:

For students who have the equivalence of their Baccalaureate degree recognized with an average numeric score, this score shall be the score from the Baccalaureate transcript (to be considered if it is submitted prior to the 9^{th} of June for the June session and prior to the 15^{th} of September for the September session).

If the student does not have the equivalence of their Baccalaureate degree recognized, in order to calculate the average score of his/her academic transcript, he/she should submit the academic transcripts containing the scores corresponding to the last two course years for the studies completed, leading to the equivalence recognition to the Spanish Baccalaureate degree.

Certifications corresponding to the studies completed in the foreign education system should be duly translated and notarized. If these certifications are not submitted (for one or both of the course years), with the date of receipt in the UNED PAU (Selectivity) Admissions Department prior to the 9th of June, for the June session and the 15th of September for the September session, an average transcript score of 5 shall be assigned for one or both of the two course years.

Once the scores have been published (21st of June for the June session and 23rd of September for the September session) and until the 31st of October, the student may request the inclusion of their real academic transcript or the document (with score) proving that the equivalence of their foreign degrees to the Spanish Baccalaureate degree has been recognized with his/her final university admission score with the new issue of the sheet, if necessary.
