



**The specific phase shall have the following characteristics:**

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1. All students may be tested on any of the subjects of the modalities established for the second course year of Baccalaureate studies in article 8 of the cited Order ESD/1729/2008, of 11 June (see Annex II). These subjects shall differ from the subject selected for the fourth exercise of the general phase.

**IMPORTANT:** If the student selects a subject in the specific phase that coincides with the subject selected for the general phase, their registration for this subject of the specific phase will be cancelled.

A student may register for a maximum of 4 subjects in the specific phase.

2. The exercises for each of the subjects selected by the student consist of offering a written response to a series of questions referring to their knowledge and capacities under assessment, with the response format ensuring the application of previously approved, objective assessment criteria.

3. The duration of each of the exercises shall be an hour and a half. A 45 minute interval shall be established between the end of one exercise and the start of the next. For purposes of exam organization, the student should indicate the subjects that they will be tested on in the entrance exam application.
