### PAU score (general and specific phase)

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The student is considered to have passed the university entrance exam if he/she has obtained a score that is equal or greater than 5 points, based on the weighed mean of 60 % of the mean score of their academic transcript and 40 % of the score from the general phase, provided that they have obtained a minimum of 4 points in the score of the general phase.

For the calculation of the mean score of the student's academic transcript, the scores reflected in the academic certifications corresponding to the last two course years of studies completed shall be reflected, leading to the degree in the Spanish Baccalaureate degree (or recognized equivalent). The resulting mean score shall be expressed in the scale of scores used in the Spanish education system, with a minimum pass of 5 and a maximum of 10 points, expressed with two decimal points, rounded to the nearest hundredth and in the case of equidistance, rounding up. In the event the student has no documentary evidence of his/her Baccalaureate scores (for one or more course years) with date of receipt in the PAU (Selectivity) Admissions Department of the UNED prior to the 9th of June and the 15th of September, this situation shall be considered to equal a 5.

For admission to the official university degree studies in which there is a competitive procedure, that is, in which the number of applications exceeds the number of places offered, public universities use a corresponding admission score for the allocation of places, which is calculated based on the following formula and is expressed to three decimal points, rounding to the nearest thousandth and in the case of equidistance, rounding up.

$$(\text{Admission score} = 0.6 \cdot \text{NMB} + 0.4 \cdot \text{CFG} + a \cdot \text{M1} + b \cdot \text{M2})$$

NMB = Mean score equivalent to the 1st and 2nd course year of Spanish Baccalaureate studies.

CFG = Score for the general phase.

M1, M2 = The two best scores for the subjects passed in the specific phase.

a, b = weighed coefficients of the subjects of the specific phase (established and published by the destination university).

The admission score shall include the scores from the subjects of the specific phase in the event these subjects relate to the branch of knowledge of the degree to which the student wishes to be admitted, in accordance with Annex I of Royal Decree 1892/2008.

The weighing parameter (a or b) for the subjects of the specific phase shall be equal to 0.1. Universities may raise this parameter to 0.2 in those subjects that are considered more convenient to successfully continue these university degree studies, in accordance with the purpose of the exam referred to in article 5 of Royal Decree 1892/2008. Universities should publish the values of said parameters for the selected subjects at the start of the course year corresponding to the exam.

The selection of these subjects shall depend on the criteria established by the university where the student wishes to study. **THE STUDENT SHOULD CONTACT THE UNIVERSITY IN WHICH THEY WISH TO REGISTER AND CHECK THEIR PREFERENTIAL SUBJECTS.**
