Bio: Fermín Moscoso del Prado leads the AI Lab at Alpha, Telefónica’s “Moonshot Factory”. He holds a Ph.D. in Linguistics from Radboud University Nijmegen in the Netherlands. Prior to his arrival at Alpha in 2018, he held positions as professor of Linguistics at the University of California, Santa Barbara, as a senior scientist in computer science, linguistics, and neuroscience, at the French Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique, as a Marie Curie Fellow in computational neuroscience at the Medical Research Council and University of Cambridge, and as a scientist in training at the Max Planck Institute for Psycholinguistics. His research experience spans a wide range of areas beyond Artificial Intelligence, including Natural Language Processing, Psycholinguistics, Cognitive Neuroscience, Statistics, Information Theory, and Causal Reasoning.
